

## 2011 KAQG QUILT SHOW RULES

1. Entrants must be a member of the Kingwood Area Quilt Guild.
2. Entry fee is \$2.00 per item. Members may enter up to three (3) items per category; only two (2) of which may be entered for judging.
3. The deadline is March 3, 2011 for receipt of the entry form, photograph, and entry fee. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. A reasonable quality color photo of your entry is required with the entry form. Photos of works-in-progress are acceptable. Someone will be available at the Guild meetings to take a photo of your entry for a nominal fee. Entrants must indicate on the entry form whether item is to be judged. Entrants must indicate on the entry form whether item is for sale and if so, list a set price. Boutique guidelines will be followed for the sale.
4. Entries must not have been exhibited in a previous KAQG show and must be complete, clean, odor-free, and in good condition.
5. Each quilt must be the work of at least one current KAQG member and entered in her/his name. Except for quilts entered in the Professionally Quilted or Group categories, each quilt shall be made by one individual only. For quilts made by more than one individual, the following rules apply:
  - a. All quilts that are professionally quilted must be entered in the professionally quilted category (i.e., professionally quilted by hand or machine for remuneration (fee, goods or services)). Quilts that are machine quilted using pantographs that form an edge-to-edge design can be entered for display only.
  - b. Non-professionally quilted quilts made by two or more people, including quilts consisting of components from a block exchange must be entered in the Group category.
6. Each entry must have a fabric identification label sewn on the lower left back of the quilt and must include the name of the quilt and the submitting member. Entries must also have a four-inch sleeve attached securely to the top of the quilt, which extends the full width of the quilt. Quilts in the miniature category may have a two-inch sleeve. **Quilts without a proper label or sleeve will not be accepted.** (Go to <http://www.blumoonriver.com/QuiltSleeve.pdf> for instructions.)
7. A quilt consists of three layers. All quilts must be quilted, whether by hand, machine or both with the following exceptions: crazy quilts, cathedral window-type quilts, and quilts made entirely with yo-yos. In the Art Miniature, Art Large, Wearable Art, and Mixed Technique categories, entries shall consist of at least two layers with sewing, stitching, tying or fastening of the two layers. Quilts made with fusible web and/or glue of some type are eligible for judging provided the fabric is also secured with stitching. Edges should be finished appropriately.
8. The entrant must select a category on the entry form. This category may be changed by the KAQG Quilt Show Chairmen, or by the judge.
9. All entrants must volunteer to work as a white-glove Quilt Angel for two hours on either Friday or Saturday during the quilt show. If any entrant fails to fulfill this two hour requirement, such entrant will be ineligible for any ribbon awards.
10. Two-sided quilts must indicate which side is to be displayed. Due to space limitations, quilts cannot be hung with both sides displayed.
11. The Quilt Show Chairmen may have to limit the number of quilts entered by a member if space limitations of the venue are exceeded. You will receive a personal call before any quilt is removed from the show due to space limitations.
12. Entrants are responsible for insuring their entries. KAQG does not purchase insurance for items exhibited during the show. In the unfortunate event that a quilt is damaged or stolen, you must place your claim with your private insurance carrier.
13. Quilts being judged will be due on Tuesday, April 12, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the home of Brenda Motl, 3714 Long Leaf Lane, Porter, TX 77365; phone: (281) 507-4239. No judged quilts will be accepted after 7:00 p.m.
14. Quilts not being judged will be due on Wednesday, April 13, 2011, at the Humble Civic Center between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. No quilts will be accepted after 7:00 p.m.
