The Debbie Caffrey pattern is called "Quilters Quandry" and was very labor intensive to make, but she was determined to finish it. MaryLee said the pattern was too hard for her to ever do again and gave it away.

MaryLee's second quilt is called "Paducah Nine Patch, which she quilted. This is made from swap blocks from several quilter friends a couple years ago. The pattern is a Pat Speth design from a book called "Nickle Quilts."

Rebecca Ward brought a quilt called "Grandmother's Flower Garden" which is quilted by the maker and Rebecca. A friend's grandmother pieced this by hand and sent it out to be hand-quilted. The grandmother didn't like the job the quilter did, so she picked out all the stitches and started quilting it herself. Rebecca is finishing the quilting and will bind it. Her friend will be giving this quilt to her son at his wedding next month.
