

New Batik Fabric Exchange

Once again we are going to be trading 2 ½” strips.

This time there is an added bonus, to gather the materials required for one of our upcoming guild workshops. If you are familiar with Suzanne Marshall’s book, that was inspired by her travels to Bali, you will be excited to learn that she will be coming to us in April. She has written several patterns that use batiks, in particular the popular Bali Pops that you have been seeing in all the quilt shops recently. Well, we are going to make our own “Kingwood Pops” by swapping batiks.

The format will be the same as before. Here are the details:

- Use only Quilt Shop quality pre-washed 100% cotton batiks, all colors are accepted
- Cut seven 2 ½” strips of the same fabric that are the full width of the piece, selvedge to selvedge
- Fold each set of strips and place in a baggie with your name and phone # written on the outside
- You can exchange as many sets as you wish and you will receive back the same number of strips but they will all be different.

Get the strips to Mary Jean and Sue on or before Business and Bee on February 18th. Strips will be returned on March 4th.
